The Historic Colonial Theater

The Colonial Arts Center was built in 1924, and community leader Garland West managed the space for entertainment and a point of pride for Buckhannon's citizens in 1930. For the next 60 years, the Colonial Theatre continued to entertain and enlighten the Buckhannon community.

Evolution to a Thriving Arts Center

After renovation into a series of bars, the old theatre faced a difficult state of disrepair. In 2016, the City of Buckhannon purchased the building to secure its role as a space for arts and entertainment. Community groups, individual supporters, and corporate partners began raising funds, and the City -with the support of public and private partners, including the WV Department of Arts, Culture, and History- began work on making the building's potential a reality. Now, nearly 100 years after the building first provided arts & entertainment for Buckhannon's citizens, **the Colonial Arts Center is getting ready for a Grand Opening in early fall of 2023!**
